#### VISITS OF COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN DIPLOMATICS AND OFFICIALS

A mission of United Kingdom officials, headed by Sir Percival Messel, K.C.B., Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Food, arrived in Ottawa on November 28 to discuss with Canadian authorities relations involving finance, trade and food supplies. The mission, headed by Sir Percival Messel, K.C.B., Permanent Secretary of the Treasury, based on trade, the position of trade, the possibility of a loan, and the financial resources available to the Canadian Government.
