My dear Principal;

For several months, I have been urging the Prime Minister of Canada to appoint an Indian Representative to the Senate while some appointments are now in consideration. I have tried to convince him that it would be a splendid monument to our Indian members of the Forces who laid down their lives in the Great War.
