### G.T.P. HAS A GREAT ROUTE.

Collingwood Schreiber Says Mountain Grade Are Very Low.

Ottawa, Aug. 23.—I am satisfied that in the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway, when it is completed, the people of Canada will have the cheapest transcontinental line in existence.

"From the Rocky Mountains to the Atlantic seaboard it will show a maximum grade of four-tenths of one per cent. east-bound and five-tenths of one per cent. west-bound. The company itself expects to obtain an equally level location across British Columbia to its Pacific terminus. I am, myself, satisfied that it will go through with a maximum grade not exceeding one per cent. and anyone who knows the first thing about railway building and the existing routes through the Rockies can readily appreciate what that means, especially in the haulage of heavy traffic.

The greatest difficulty lies in the scarcity of labor. In one stable I saw twenty horses idle because it was impossible to secure drivers to handle them.
