ECLIPSES.

In the Year 1890 there will be two eclipses of the Sun and one of the Moon.

I. An annular eclipse of the Sun, June 17, 1890, visible as a partial eclipse in Europe; visible in Asia and Africa; invisible in North America.

II. A partial eclipse of the Moon, November 26, 1890, invisible in North America; visible generally in Asia, Indian and Pacific oceans.

III. A total eclipse of the Sun, December 11, 1890, invisible in North America; visible in Australia, Indian and South Atlantic oceans.

MORNING AND EVENING STARS.

Venus is a morning star until February 18, and evening star until December 3, then morning

Maps is a morning star until May 27, then evening star. Jupiter is an evening star until January 10, a morning star until July 30, afterwards evening

Saturn is a morning star February 18, an evening star until August 30, afterwards morning

The planets will be brightest. Venus, October 29; Mars, May 27; Jupiter, July 30; Saturn, February 18; Mercury, January 13, May 6, September 24, December 28, setting closely after the sun in the evening; also February 23, June 24 and October 1, rising immediately before the sun in the morning.
