The amount of the subscription lists for the year was \$4,260, which is a small increase upon the last year's receipts. From this sum \$738.18 was, in accordance with the rules of the Society, reserved for special purposes by the Parishes.

WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' FUND.

The income of this fund steadily increases, for the Committee have hitherto been able yearly to add something to the Capital, and the charges upon it remain as before, \$340 per annum. The Committee hold securities for this object to the amount of \$14,330. The income of the fund for 1863, not counting donations or back premiums, was \$1,641.

It is much to be regretted that in some of the Parishes, even where the clergyman has a personal interest in the fund, the collections are entirely neglected, while in several others they are not regularly made. This is manifestly unfair upon those who are doing their best for the benefit of the fund, and betrays a want of interest which makes the Committee hesitate to increase the pension.

Accounting to \$1,000 from the "reserved fund" and to deposit with the Society in York, with the interest payable annually, the amount. The Sub-Committee now hold securities for about \$13,010 belonging to this fund. Since its formation in
