J. T. Wylde Esq., was appointed to the Superannuation Committee,

vice Col. Myers, deceased.

The Committee on increase of Income, presented their report. In accordance therewith, the Committee appointed the Church-Wardens of each of the City parishes to be Sub-Committees, for the purpose of soliciting Subscriptions to D. C. S. from those who have not already Subscribed for 1867.

The grant to Rawdon of an additional £60 for the year 1866, was passed. Notice of motion was given that the estimated value of Rawdon Glebe and parsonage as made in 1865, be not considered permanent.

The place of residence for the Assistant Missionary at Digby Neck, and the duties he should perform were left to the Bishop to determine.

A draft of the Report was read and submitted by the Secretary. It was then adopted as the Report of the Executive Committee and ordered to be printed as usual.

WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' FUND.

DEC. 8, 1866.—It was agreed by the Sub-Committee that the increased rate of premium of a Clergyman lately gone to reside in Bermuda should be 33½ per cent.

A certificate was granted to the Rev. J. P. Sargent upon the usual

terms, viz. the payment of all back premiums.

A certificate, forfeited for non payment in due time, was renewed

upon payment of a fine.

The Sub-Committee expressed an opinion in favor of investing in Bond and Mortgage, care being taken to obtain such securities as would be readily available.

There are now fifty three clergymen holding certificates, one of whom

resides in Bermuda and three in P. E. I.

Their united premiums amount to \$581.48 per annum.

The claims upon the Fund amount in all to \$1200 per annum.
