WARNS AGAINST REDS IN TORONTO

Minister's Statement on Conference on Unemployment Question.

Toronto, April 28-While a deputation from the unemployed was at a meeting of the board of control here carried on during the winter and early spring, and still carried on to a limited extent, another deputation added significance to the gathering.

This consisted of Rev. T. C. Brown, Rev. J. A. Miller, Rev. Dean Hand and ex-controller W. P. Hubbard, representing the House of Industry, and it was present to urge that
