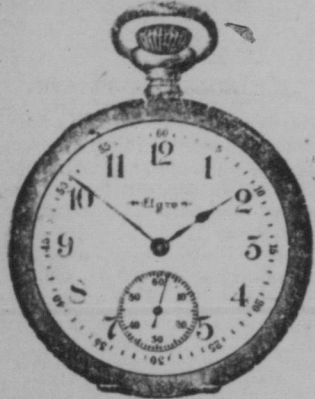

"I think my father wants Tom, mother," said Maggie; "he must come into the parlour first."

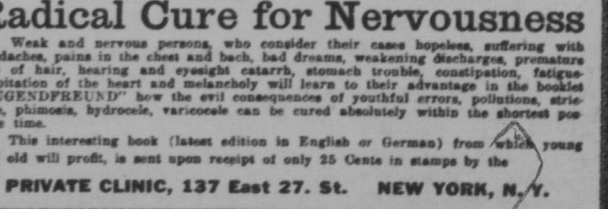
