

Steeplechase racing is the Englishman's delight and the Grand National is the blue ribbon of the turf. It is to the lovers of the "leppers" what the Suburban handicap is to us.

Having won the Derby three times, King Edward would dearly love to see his colors home first in a Grand National, but despite repeated efforts, this pleasure has ever been denied Edward VII.

What this means can only be appreciated by one who knows the Grand National course. The horse runs at racing pace, takes 30 jumps, any one of which is enough to make an ordinary timber topper hesitate, and finishes with enough reserve power to stall off the rush of the rest.
