


CZAR'S Austro-German Forces Driven Back Along Fifteen Mile Front South of Denister River --- Town

London, Aug. 8. The Russians have renewed their attacks on the Gaucasus front, west of Erzingan. An official Turkish statement re-ceived here today, dated August 5, says the Russians gained a footing in the Turkish lines, but were driven out, after heavy fighting.
