gether with a schedule in the form hereunto annexed, marked "A", and an affidavit in the form as near as may be in the form of affidavit annexed to this Act, made by the Crown Prosecutor and sworn to before a Justice of the Peace, which said papers shall be filed in the Crown office by the Clerk of the Crown.

Qualification.

VI. No person shall be appointed a Crown Prosecutor under this Act unless he is a Barrister of at least three years standing.

Commencement of Act. VII. This Act shall come into force and effect, upon, from and after the first day of January, 1855.
