

An Act to amend section thirty-nine of chapter thirty-seven of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting the authentication of Certificates of Discharge, executed before witnesses.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows : Preamble.

1. Hereafter it shall be sufficient for the authentication of any Certificate of discharge, executed before witnesses, as provided by section thirty-nine of chapter thirty-seven of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, if one of the witnesses shall, upon oath before any one of the Judges of the Court of Queen's Bench or Superior Court, or before any commissioner for taking affidavits, either in Upper or Lower Canada, or in Great Britain or Ireland, to be used in the Superior Court, or before a Judge of any of the Superior Courts of Law or Equity, or any Judge of a County Court within his County in Upper Canada, or before the Registrar or his deputy, prove that he saw such Certificate signed by the party granting it. One witness only to swear to authenticity of certificates of discharge.
