In reply to your letter of the 7th instant, I have the honour to inform you, that there is not any Lighthouse at this port.

Two lanthorns with common lamps, without reflectors, were placed at the lower masthead of the flag-staff for lights to shipping in 1823, which were removed in December last, and a flag-staff lanthorn on Captain Smith's (Madras Engineer) principle, with two argand lamps and reflectors substituted; I am unable to state the first cost of these lanthorns, as
