Sir,  
Referring to my letter of the 19<sup>th</sup> May last, transmitting a list of lands, the sales of which were liable to be cancelled, I beg to call attention to a remark which I made in connection with Lots 2 & 3, 4<sup>th</sup> Range, Jones Survey, - viz:

"Emily Balster (in whose name these lots were purchased) has been dead some two or three years. Her husband has built on and improved the lots. I would suggest that in this case the sale be cancelled and the lots ordered to be sold to John C. Balster on payment of arrears."

I now enclose a statement of Mr. Balster, and also a Declaration of his Children (the Children also of the deceased Emily Balster).

I can testify that Mr. Balster is an honest industrious man, and I verily believe the statements made by him are perfectly correct.
