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Ottawa, 31st August 1915.

Sir,-

With further reference to your letter of the 9th ultimo I beg to inform you that the Indians of the Sarcee Band have stated informally that the road you desire to establish, may be made without compensation to them.

A written consent will be obtained later on.

It appears to be understood on the part of the Indian Agent and the Indians that your Department will construct such fencing as may be required on each side of the proposed road and especially place two gates across the land which the road will cross.
