At the regular monthly meeting of the Council of the Chippewas of the Thames, Caradoc Reserve, held on the foregoing date in the presence of Henry James, Esq., Indian Agent, it was moved by Elijah Burch seconded by Job Fisher that a Permit be granted to Myles McDougald to remove and sell the gravel on a parcel of land situated on the river bank on the southerly part of Lot One, Range Six, Caradoc Reserve and that said Myles McDougald to pay to the Band twenty-five cents for every cord of gravel removed off of the Reserve and that said Myles McDougald to report to the Chippewa Council of the Thames from time to time as to the quantity of gravel removed off the Indian Reserve, the Permit to have effect only for three years from the foregoing date, and that the Department be asked to sanction the same.
