
Ottawa 25th November, 1901.

Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, reporting in regard to the case of the woman Anna Nikawennaha and the old Indian Attiatonenthí ; and in reply I beg to say that you may render assistance to the value of five dollars to Anna Nikawennaha if she is in want and has <sup>no</sup> means of ~~xxxxx~~ obtaining provisions, etc.

With reference to the Indian Attiatonenthí I beg to say that the Department does not, as you are aware, afford assistance to those Indians who have near relatives able to support them .


