I note your remarks with regard to the Shingwauk Home at Sault Ste. Marie. This building is not the property of the Department and we are not at all responsible for its up-keep. The Church of England owns this school building, and should attend to matters such as you mention. In view of all the circumstances, I would be disposed to give Mr. Fuller some assistance to enable him to put on these screens which are very necessary.

I shall communicate with Mr. Fuller.
