- (111) Trials were held on the M-Scope pipe finder as an A Tk mine detector. The trials were not satisfactory and will be repeated.
- (iv) Substitutes for galvanized iron neils are being experimented with. Both wooden and plastic neils are under consideration.
- (v) A substitute for roofing and building papers is being worked on.
- (vi) The party fevour, anti-mine device, was given a further test which showed hopeful results.
- (vii) Further models of the Bailey Bridge were completed and shipped.
- (viii) Considerable experiment was done on the use of fluorescent paints and activated by ultra violet light.
