**RADCLIFFE, WILLIAM**—Corporal. Born 21st March, 1883, at Burslem, Staffordshire, England. Father, William Radcliffe, Decorator. Educated at St. John's Public School. Winner of a scholarship at the Josiah Wedgwood Institute. Entered the service of the Company, 15th September, 1912. Enlisted, 19th November, 1914, in Canadian Army Medical Corps, with the rank of Private. Transferred to 27th Canadian Battalion. Promoted Corporal, February, 1917. Principal actions: St. Eloi, 1915; Sanctuary Wood, Somme, 1916; Fresnoy, Vimy, Lens, 1917. Demobilized, 19th November, 1917, on account of sickness. Subsequent occupation: In charge of the Engineering Branch, Soldiers' Civil Re-establishment, Winnipeg, 1st April, 1919.
