This sample is brought to our office and examined by our own expert, at the same time it is being examined by the Government Inspector. Should samples become mixed, or any mistake be made in the Government grading, we have a safe check, or should our expert consider that you do not receive the highest possible grade for your grain, he at once takes the matter up with the Chief Inspector, and, if it is not possible to have a satisfactory change made, we are in a position to order a reinspection at Fort William, before your car is unloaded.

The satisfaction which we have given our shippers by protecting their interests in this and other ways is plainly shown in the increase of our business. We have handled up to the present time this business year about 15,500,000 BUSHELS. If you have not shipped your grain yet, we trust you will consign it to your own Company and help strengthen the farmers' cause.
