After which Mr. Speaker delivered to his Excellency a Bill for appropriating the Supplies granted this present Seffion, and spake as follows, viz;

May it please your Excellency,

IS Majesty's most faithful subjects the Commons of Nova-Scotia, have paid particular attention to the feveral objects recommended by your Excellency in your Speech, at the opening of this Selfion of General-Affembly, and have granted fuch Supplies as they conceive will be fufficient to defray the Annual Expences of this Government. I am directed iu their name Humbly to Pray your Excellency will be pleased to Assent to their Bill for appropriating those Supplies.

His Excellency was pleafed to give his Affent to the faid Bill following viz.

An Act, for applying certain Monies therein mentioned for the Service of the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and Ninety fix, and for appropriating fuch Part of the Supplies granted in this Seffion of General Affembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province.

After which his Excellency was pleafed to make the following Speech, viz.

Mr. President and Gentlemen of the Conncil.

Mr. Speaker and Gentlemen of the Affembly.

HE object of our Assembling being accomplished, it only remains for me to prefent you my Thanks for the Diligence and Harmony with which your Deliberations have been conducted.

The Provisions made for improving Roads, and crecting Bridges, together with the preparatory Arrangement for public Buildings, will produce I truft, lasting advantages to the Province, and reflect Credit upon your Wildom and public Spirit.

Mr. Speaker and Gentlemen of the Affembly.

I thank you for the Supplies granted for the Support of his Majesty's Government, which shall be faithfully applied, and I hope the Benefits refulting from mutual Confidence and Kindnefs, will be continued by your Influence throughout your refpective Districts.

And afterwards the Prefident of his Majesty's Council by his Excellency's command, faid;

GENTLEMEN,

It is his Excellency's will and pleafure, that this General Assembly, be prorogued to Thursday the 7th Day of July, to be then here held; and this General Affembly, is accordingly prorogued to Thursday the 7th Day of July next.
