

## PROCLAMATION.

## BY HIS EXCELLENCY

## SIR JOHN WENTWORTH, BARONET, L.L.D.

Lieutenant-Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies, Sc. Sc.

THEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday the Seventh day of January next:

I have therefore thought fit, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Council, further to proregue the faid General Assembly, from the Seventh of January next, unto Thursday, the Twenty-fifth day of February, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Two, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business: of which, all persons concerned, are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms, at Halifax, this 23d day of December, 1801, and in the 42d year of His Majesty's Reign.
