



PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY

SIR JOHN WENTWORTH, BARONET, L.L.D.

*Lieutenant-Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-
Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c. &c.*

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Province stands prorogued to
Thursday the Seventh day of January next:

*I have therefore thought fit, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Council, further
to prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY, from the Seventh of January next, unto
Thursday, the Twenty-fifth day of February, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Two,
then to meet for the Dispatch of Business: of which, all persons concerned, are hereby
required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.*

*GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms, at Halifax, this 23d day of December, 1801,
and in the 42d year of His Majesty's Reign.*
