## A PROCLAMATION.

We thought fit to proregue Our Provincial Parliament to the FOURTH day of the month of DECEMBER instant, at which time, at Our City of Toronto, you were held and constrained to appear. Now Know YE, that for divers causes and considerations, and taking into consideration the ease and convenience of Our Loving Subjects, We have thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Executive Council, to relieve you, and each of you, of your attendance at the time aforesaid, hereby convoking and by these presents enjoining you and each of you, that on TUESDAY, the THIRTEENTH day of the month of JANUARY next, you meet Us, in Our Provincial Parliament, at Our City of Toronto, there to take into consideration the state and welfare of Our said Province of Canada, and therein to do as may seem necessary. Herein Fail Not.

In Testimony Whereor, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of Our said Province of Canada to be hereunto affixed: Witness, Our Trusty and Well-Beloved Sir Edmund Walker Head, Baronet, Governor General of British North America, and Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over Our Provinces of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and the Island of Prince Edward, and Vice Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c. At Our Government House, in Our City of TORONTO in Our said Province, this THIRD day of DECEMBER, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and in the Twentieth year of Our Reign.
