**W**HEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands Prorogued until Friday the Tenth day of October instant : And Whereas I think fit to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Saturday the Twenty-ninth day of November next ensuing. I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said General Assembly until Saturday the Twenty-ninth day of November next ; of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

at St. John's, in the aforesaid Island, the Fourth day  
of October, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty  
Six, and in the Twentieth Year of Her Majesty's  
Reign.
