This objective is to bring about a complete reorganization of the feder- al reserve board, which is the head and front of the federal reserve mon- etary system of the U. S.

It is claimed that the reserve board is now completely under the control of either bankers or men who think as the bankers do. It is primarily a bankers' board, which looks at U. S. finance through the spectacles of the banks.

What the progressives purpose to do is to take a large leaf out of the experience of Great Britain with the Bank of England. The directorate of the Bank of England, as many know and many do not know, is not in ship is made up of men who are not in the banking business and whose concern primarily is the general credit of the public, of the commercial, industrial and agricultural, as well as other basic interests.

What the progressives and farmer members of Congress have in their minds is to make up the federal re- serve board of agriculturists, labor representatives, representatives of small business, and, in small mea- sure, of representation form big busi- ness or the financial and banking in- terests. They would have three re- presentatives of agriculture, two of labor, two of small business, and one of big business.
