#### PARCEL POST NOTICE.

#### Reduction in Weight.

Until the opening of navigation parcel delivery on many of the present routes must be partially, and in some places, entirely suspended, and the difficulty of securing dog teams and weather conditions making it extremely difficult to convey heavy mails over tracks impassable for horses. The maximum weight of parcels for winter courier routes, until the end of April, is decreased from 11 pounds to 5 pounds, and these can only be accepted in small numbers. Whilst every effort will be made to deliver parcels the Department cannot guarantee prompt delivery. This does not apply to places on the line of Railway, but only to delivery by courier. Postmasters in Outports are requested to put this regulation into effect.
