Shawkey Outpitches Coveleskie in Opening Game—Love Starts for Highlanders in Second—Washington Loses to Cleveland Through Poor Pitching and Fielding.

NEW YORK, July 17.—Playing with a team consisting largely of utility men, New York increased its lead in the pennant chase today by twice defeating Detroit, the scores being 2 to 0 and 3 to 2.

In the first game, Shawkey outpitched Coveleskie, permitting only one Detroit player to reach third base. In the second game Love, a New York youngster, started his first game of the season, and gave a fine exhibition until the eighth inning, when Donovan took him out after he allowed two hits, Russell replacing him.

J. Franklin Baker, the hard hitting third baseman of the Yankees, was out of the game, and will be unable to play for some time. An x-ray photograph of the injuries he received last Friday revealed the fracture of two ribs. Boone will replace Baker until the latter is able to resume play.

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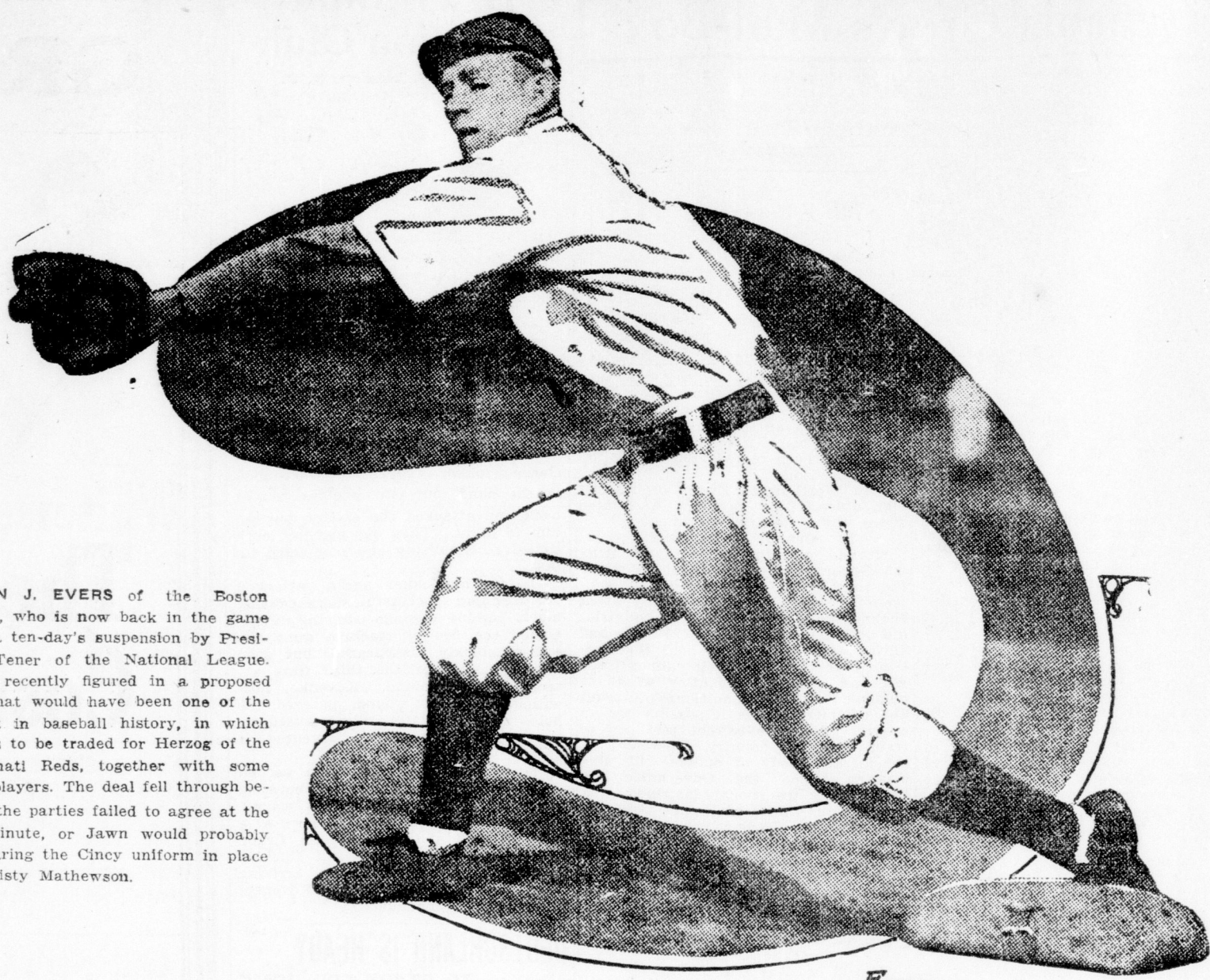
