FLINTERS' GIVE TECS A BATTLE --- MINT SCOUTS' HAPPY HUNTING GROUND

Flinters' Presumptions On First Call Make It 10-Frame 4-3 Pastime

Londoners Run Wild On Bases, Shay Stealing Home Twice — Sensational Fielding Featured by Both, and Three London Errors.

It was the turn of the men of Halli-son to be entertained over at the riverside yesterday afternoon, and the party lasted ten innings. George Washington Stutz gave the guests their hats, when he smashed out a double to the right and the left, the scoring Vandye with London's fourth run.

Considering the difference in their social standing, the Flint club acted a bit "nouveau riche" yesterday, but the hosts went through the game with varying degrees of politeness. Then the bat, with a regular abandon on the bases, Shay was the boldest brigand on the team, stealing no less than two bases and two home plates, with Stutz and Schaefer taking two sacks each. In the fielding department, the Flinters abounded in a few more flashes than the visitors, and they also grabbed three more smashes off the bat than the Londoners. The Flinters' pitcher, Dugray, was a real find. He pitched a perfect game to second and to the outfield, and he even grabbed off more misplays than the Londoners, having three misplays, but only the first one did any damage.

Presumption Galore.

This was what gave Flint the presumption to start right off by hanging up marks for their hosts to shoot at. They hung up a 10-4 in the first frame, when Gray, on through a scratch hit down to second, and Roseberry, with a cheeper seat than that, Bill Kuhn allowed to drop.

These were cheap looking, but the Flinters looked cheap toward the end of the same frame. Vandye grounded out, Shay hit safely to his own right, and the second, and Schaefer hit to the same place. With two gone, and while Shurlov was working over Malmquist, Shay and Schaefer started a tandem pilfer, and ended it successfully. Schaefer was brought in by Malmquist's good hit to left, so things were even again.

This didn't bring the uncouth Flinters to their senses, however, and they went on to hang up a 10-4 in the second frame. Dugray's liner which discouraged them temporarily, and the Flinters bounced up to a serene as ever, Gray showing the bad example to his crowd by banging out a home run, and Schaefer hitting a home run. Schaefer hit along to third, from where he scored when Roseberry's choice to Pinto didn't give the Londoners much time for the play at the plate. The umpire ruled Dolly safe, and this happened to be their last. Even as they didn't know it at the time, they were kept on trying right to the end, until the tenth.

In the fourth it was only a lightning double play by Stutz and Schaefer that kept them within bounds. Dugray had remained on first after he shot a hard one down to the grass, and Stutz's sacrifice bunt caught Dolly with his foot off the base. Jordan laid down a sacrifice, which Stutz came in for. Dugray made a double advance, however, and rounded second, thinking he could beat George Wash to the Pinto Master Here.

After that Pinto was at himself. True, he kicked the Flinters' hot snuff, but he was a long way off. He watched Roseberry's long lust go through Schaefer's legs and on out.
