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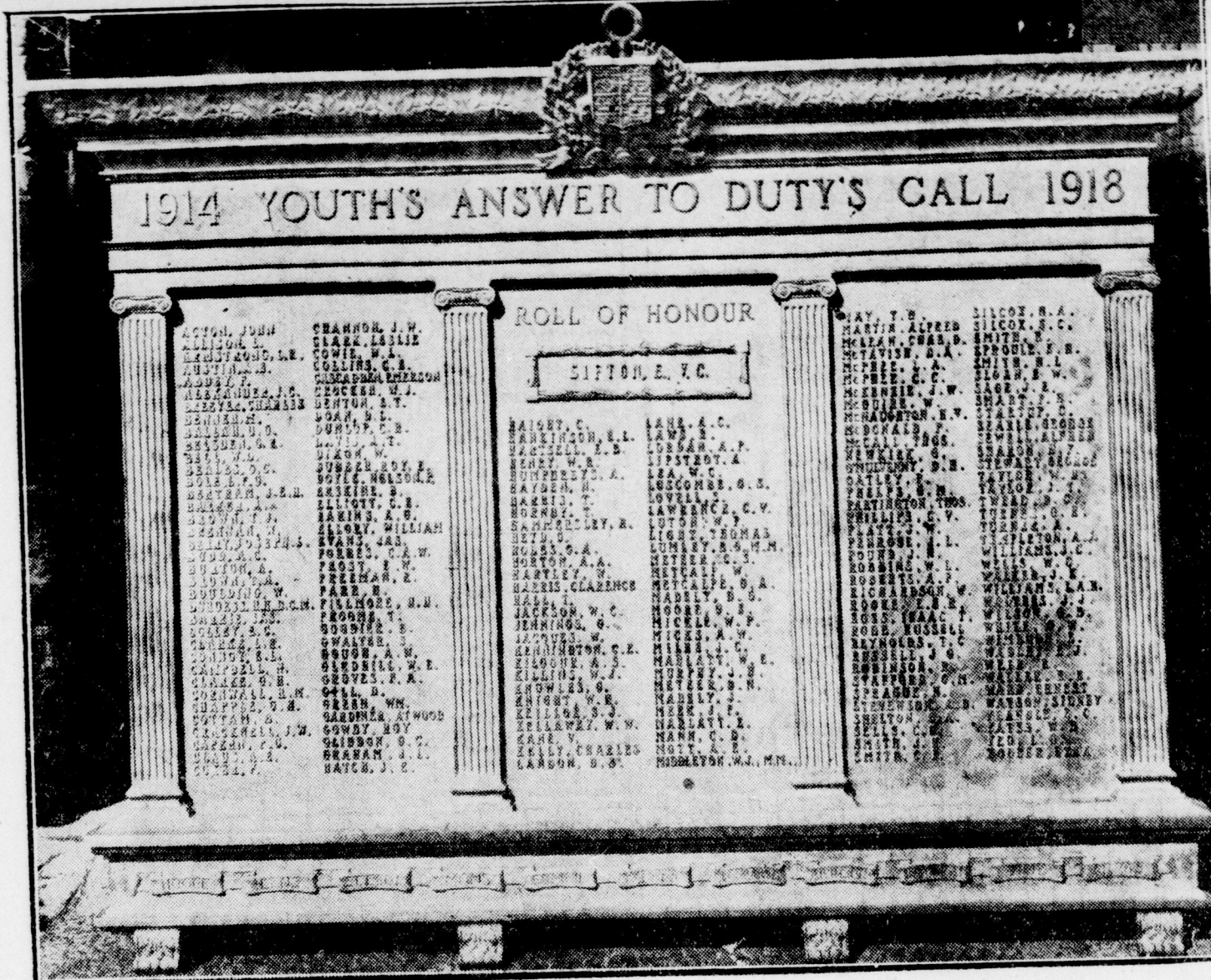
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ST. THOMAS' TRIBUTE TO SOLDIER DEAD.

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LIEUT.-COL. A. M. SMITH DIES SUDDENLY AT CITY RESIDENCE

London Loses One of Best Known Businessmen and Sportsman.

WAS BORN IN 1853

Lieut.-Colonel Albert M. Smith, one of London's best known businessmen, sportsman and military man, died at his home, Belvedere, Wortley road, Saturday at noon.

His death was totally unexpected. He was apparently in the best of health up until Saturday morning when he complained of feeling unwell, but considered himself afflicted with only a slight attack of indigestion.

He was 71 years of age. The death of Lieut.-Colonel Smith has removed one of the best loved and most picturesque characters in the city. Noted for his benevolence and public spirit, an amazing variety of interest engaged his attention throughout life.

He was born on the 11th of 1853, at Fergus, Ont., the eldest son of W. Simpson Smith of Montreal, Ireland. He was educated in the city of London, where he held an appointment as a clerk in the city of London.
