THE CHOLERA IN ITALY.

KING HUMBERT VISITS THE STRICKEN CITY OF NAPLES.

Eight Hundred New Cases and Three Hundred Deaths—Impressive Scene at a Church—The Plague in Spain and France. Rome, Sept. 9.—Six hundred and thirty-three fresh cases of cholera; 275 deaths reported at Naples this past 24 hours. 131 fresh cases and 66 deaths reported at other places in Italy.

In Naples the condition is most harrowing. Scenes of misery and wretchedness of a most pitiable character occur on every side. The king has been profoundly affected by the sufferings he has witnessed. He has made a first donation of twenty thousand to the relief fund. His majesty gave an audience to the municipal authorities last night. The royal party visited the poor sections of the city to-day. The streets will be converted into a hospital.

The conductor of a railway train from Naples was attacked by cholera yesterday during the journey and soon died. The entire receipts of the great charity fete yesterday at Turin will be devoted to the cholera sufferers.

King Humbert, after visiting the poorer portions of Naples to-day, inspected the Carlo-Alberto hospital. He declined the use of disinfectants while making a tour of the wards. The king was accompanied by his brother, the duke of Aosta, Signor Depretis, minister of interior, and Mancini, minister of foreign affairs.

The burial of the victims of the cholera is difficult, owing to the unusually large number. During the last 24 hours there were 800 fresh cases of cholera and 300 deaths. Naples presents a gloomy aspect. The images of saints with alyattes bearing lamps have been borne at the head of processions of women through the principal streets, who invoked the aid of the Virgin. A large crowd assembled outside the church of St. Charles, and the consequence of the report that the Virgin Mary had descended upon the altar and bestowed her blessings on the people. The doors of the church were closed, and the crowd attempted to break them open.

Troops arriving, the doors were opened and the multitude rushed in and fell upon their knees in fervent prayer. King Humbert paid a visit to the Conocchia hospital. Immense crowds attended him. Bandages have been lighted. Disinfectants are freely used.

MADRID, Sept. 9.—Thirteen cases and four deaths at Elche since last evening. At Novelda, six cases and two deaths. BARCELONA, Sept. 9.—Five new cases of cholera to-day.

France Will Declare War. PARIS, Sept. 9.—It is officially stated that war will shortly be declared against China. The occupation of Formosa has already been abandoned. A fresh expedition has already been prepared. The whole question will be discussed at Saturday's cabinet council. There are certain indications which lead to believe that the government will take important action regarding operations in China, and necessitate the summoning of the chambers.

Northbrook's Mission. LONDON, Sept. 9.—England has informed the powers which recently entered the Egyptian conference that the first object of Northbrook's mission is to invest the Alexandria indemnities preparatory to a settlement of the delta of the river Nile. It is popular with all parties. Admiral Hewitt will only be authorized to hoist a flag at present, but the government will sustain further annexation of the Rann and Escondido. Gladstone is reporting the fact of the German overtures states that the native chiefs will accept German control.

Redistribution of Seats. LONDON, Sept. 9.—The home office officials have been ordered to furnish reports showing the population and areas of the different electoral divisions so that Gladstone can make a statement of the scheme for the redistribution of seats on the opening of parliament. Gladstone, however, will insist upon the precedence of the franchise bill.

Canibalism Not a Crime. LONDON, Sept. 9.—The arrest of Capt. Dudley and the two other survivors of the wreck of the Mignonette, is looked upon as a formality, as it is considered certain that no British jury can be brought to convict them of murder for saving their own lives by hastening the death of a doomed comrade.

No Chance for Cholera in London. LONDON, Sept. 9.—The official report of the city sewers' commission says that London was never cleaner or healthier or safer from nuisance than now. If cholera comes it can't remain long nor assume alarming proportions.

Fighting the French Divorce Law. ROME, Sept. 9.—The Vatican has forwarded to the French government a note declaring the divorce law at war with the doctrine of the catholic church. An encyclical is about to be issued upon the subject addressed to the French catholics.

Arrived at Alexandria. ALEXANDRIA, Sept. 9.—Wolsley and Northbrook arrived to-day and proceeded to Cairo. The whole city turned out to see them.

Something Wrong With the Fire Alarm System. About 10.40 last night an alarm of fire was sounded from box 12, Front and Bathurst streets. The bells were soon on the alert. Here they were told the fire was at the corner of Brook and King streets. When The World arrived four rods were waiting at the corner of Bathurst and Stafford streets, when an alarm sounded from box 95, which is opposite the Toronto bridge works on King street west. The fire was only a small altar, and was extinguished before \$10 damage had been done.

UNITED STATES NEWS.

The American historical association was organized at Saratoga yesterday. Sioux city, Ia., was yesterday devastated by a terrific hail and wind storm. The daughter of George Tuttle was killed by lightning at Middleton, N.H., Monday night.

The coal miners of four Monongahela pools will remain on strike until higher wages are paid. Oliver Biteman has confessed to murdering two little girls at Savannah, Mo., and will probably be lynched.

The heat was almost unbearable in New York yesterday. A number of cases of prostration were reported, one fatally. W. R. Lyell, a reporter, killed Daniel Gregg, locomotive engineer, in an altercation on the fair grounds at Chicago yesterday.

The telegraph, telephone and electric light companies at Philadelphia have been notified to place all their wires under ground before Jan. 1.

Mrs. Joseph Thompson, while temporarily insane, attempted to kill her two grown up daughters, but was prevented from doing so by her husband, although one was badly cut.

The Chicago live stock exchange will purchase ten healthy cattle to be presented to the live stock commission for the purpose of being placed in the herd claimed to be afflicted with pleuro pneumonia until such time as will prove that the suspected disease does not exist.

New Brunswick, (N. J.), Sept. 9.—City officials admit that the city is hopelessly bankrupt, and confess that for years it has been dependent on the suspended bank.

People are still hanging around the suspended bank. Notes are accepted, but no depositors are paid. The report of Director Letson's death is false. He was overcome by heat. Jarrard, the former postmaster, who is now in Tinton jail, was so affected by the news of the suicide of Hill and Raynor that he had hemorrhage. The city is paralyzed. Work is suspended, stores are closed, and industry is at a standstill. Arrests of directors are to be made.

Stove-menders' Troubles at Cincinnati. CINCINNATI, Sept. 9.—The stove-menders' situation is growing more serious. Chamberlain's foundry, which had been at work, has now stopped and joined the other manufacturers. The few men who are at work at the other foundries are virtually imprisoned, it being dangerous to them to appear on the streets.

Secretary's Folger's Funeral. GENEVA, N.Y., Sept. 9.—The funeral of the late secretary of the United States treasury took place here to-day, being witnessed by 40,000 people. President Arthur and his cabinet were present, also Governor Cleveland. The eulogy was long and imposing, congress, the bar and the bench being largely represented.

Are There any Like Him in Canada? CAMDEN, N.J., Sept. 9.—H. B. Price, collector, justice of the peace, has been arrested twice since yesterday. It is said there are more marks to be served upon him to-morrow. His offences consist of firing negroes and other poor and ignorant persons illegally.

A Fatal Mistake. COLUMBUS, O., Sept. 9.—Wm. Callison, telegraph operator on duty in the Evening valley, was shot and killed by Ganer Beaton last night, being mistaken for a striking miner, who was supposed to be firing one of the hoppers.

What a Cow Did. MEMPHIS, Tenn., Sept. 9.—A passenger train was thrown off the track by a cow near Corinth last night. Seventy passengers were bruised. A brakeman and a colored girl were severely hurt.

The Fatal Heat. NEW YORK, Sept. 9.—Seventeen persons were overcome by the heat to-day. Three died. In Brooklyn there were many prostrations and several deaths. Five deaths at Philadelphia.

An Incendiary Menced. ARKANSAS CITY, Ark., Sept. 9.—Matt Orten was arrested, charged with firing the buildings burned yesterday. He was hanged by an infuriated mob this morning.

The Local Elections. PORTLAND, Sept. 9.—The latest returns show that the senate stands 29 republicans, 2 democrats. House 82 republicans, 21 democrats. Majority for Robie, governor, 17,000.
