A JUDGE BY PROXY. An Interesting Decision by Justice Rose Governing the Extent to Which

Osgoode Hall, Dec. 5, 1930. Mr. Justice Rose has given judgment upon the motion by plaintiff in the Division Court, Ferguson, J., vs. Middleton for a mandamus to the judge of the County of Elgin. He holds that the mandamus proceeding is an action within sec. 87 of Division Courts Act, and was properly transferred from the 10th Division Court of York to the 3rd of Elgin.

There is no reason why statutory provision should not be made in cases of this kind, where a County Court Judge is incapacitated through illness, even without consent of parties, where the litigants are anxious to have their cases tried, a method of formal disposition upon consent should be provided.

The net exports of gold at New York since Jan. 1 are \$80,250,000, as against \$89,150,000 in 1929, and \$83,343,000 in 1928.

Total Chicago east-bound shipments for November were 239,293 tons, an increase over last year of 112,704 tons.
