extremely striking one, and those who made the trip by Fell's railway are not likely to have forgotten the sensation they experienced at this point, where the little railway seemed as if really suspended above the abyss, so close did it run to the verge of the precipice. Above the redoubt a torrent forms a beautiful waterfall. On the right bank three forts occupy the crest of rocks rising one above the other.
