AN ELEGANT SERVICE.

A gentleman who arrived in Winnipeg this week from the east via the Canadian Pacific Railway, was heard to express himself very enthusiastically regarding the service furnished by the company over the great Canadian transcontinental line. The service he said was equal to the best he had found anywhere, and every possible comfort and convenience was supplied passengers. The gentleman said he had been travelling for some weeks on various railways in the United States, but he found nothing better, if equal, to the Canadian road.
