## Antiphlogistine

(Inflammation's Antidote.)



## **PNEUMONIA**

Apply over the thoracic walls, front, sides and back, and cover with a cotton-lined cheesecloth jacket, as shown in the illustration.

## **BRONCHITIS**

Apply over and well beyond the sterno clavicular region. If a dressing is put on when symptoms of bronchial irritation first appear, a serious development may be prevented.

## **PLEURISY**

Apply over and well beyond the boundaries of the inflammation. In all cases Antiphlogistine must be applied at least  $\frac{1}{5}$  inch thick, as hot as the patient can bear comfortably and be covered with a plentiful supply of absorbent cotton and a bandage.
