"REPORT OF THE CO-ORDINATOR OF THE CONTACT GROUP ON ELEMENT IX (GENERAL PROVISIONS ON VERIFICATION)

"ELEMENT IX - MIGHT CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING POINTS:

"1. <u>Purpose</u> of verification: to provide assurance of compliance with the provisions of the Convention (CD 220).

"2. <u>Scope</u> of verification: appropriate and agreed verification measures should be applied on the basis of the principle of reciprocity to, <u>inter alia</u>:

- (a) Elements I-IV, concerning prohibition of development, production, other acquisition, stockpiling, retention and transfer of chemical weapons;
- (b) Elements I and V, concerning destruction or otherwise disposal of existing stocks of chemical weapons and their means of production; over an agreed period of time;
- (c) Element VI concerning super-toxic lethal chemicals for non-hostile military purposes;
- (d) Enquiry into facts, including on-site verification on an agreed basis, on questions related to alleged contravention of the terms of the convention.

"3. Means of verification:

- Technical means of verification: Element IX could indicate that agreed techniques of verification appropriate to the task required are identified under each substantive head (now contained in Elements II-VI);
- (b) <u>Organizational</u> means of Verification: Element IX could provide for the establishment of a Consultative Committee to act as a permanent body for the monitoring of the implementation of and compliance with the terms of the Convention.
