Born in Chicoutimi, Quebec on July 6, 1914. He is a graduate of the University of Montreal and studied at McGill University and at George Washington University.

Mr. Tremblay was called to the Bar of Province of Quebec and practised law in Montreal.

In 1940 he joined Department of External Affairs as Third Secretary and served abroad in Canadian diplomatic Missions at Washington, D.C.
