

**PART I**  
**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**ARTICLE 1**

**Definitions**

In this Administrative Agreement:

- (a) The term “Convention” means the *Convention on Social Security between Canada and the Republic of Peru*, done at .....Ottawa..... on .....10 April..... 2014.
- (b) The term “Administrative Agreement” means the *Administrative Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Republic of Peru for the Implementation of the Convention on Social Security between Canada and the Republic of Peru*.
- (c) Any other term shall have the meaning assigned to it in the Convention.

**ARTICLE 2**

**Liaison Agencies and Competent Institutions**

- 1. The Parties designate the following organizations as their liaison agencies:
  - (a) for Canada:
    - (i) the International Operations Division, Service Canada, Department of Human Resources and Skills Development, in regard to all provisions except Articles 6 to 9 of the Convention and Article 3 of this Administrative Agreement; and
    - (ii) the Legislative Policy Directorate, Canada Revenue Agency for the application of Articles 6 to 9 of the Convention and Article 3 of this Administrative Agreement.
  - (b) for the Republic of Peru (“Peru”):
    - (i) the *Oficina de Normalización Previsional* (ONP) for all provisions of the Convention regarding the rights of insured persons of the National Pension System (SNP), except Articles 6 to 9 of the Convention and Article 3 of this Administrative Agreement;
