Leave London for Istanbul at 1200 by RCAF-C5 to arrive there at 2030 on the same day.

May 1

Meeting of the Ministerial Summit Working-group on Disarmament, consisting of the Foreign Ministers of the Five Western Members of the Disarmament Committee, the United States, the United Kingdom, France, Italy and Canada.

Leave Istanbul at 1005 for London by RCAF-C5 to arrive there at 1730 on the same day.
