Ordered, That the Report be now received.

Mr. Blondin reported the Resolution accordingly, and the same was read, as followeth:—

Resolved, That it is expedient (a) to provide for the incorporation of a Board of Trustees of the National Gallery of Canada, and to transfer the property in the said Gallery to and vest it in the said Board as Trustees for the Government of Canada; (b) to authorize the Board to acquire pictures, statuary, works of art and other property; and (c) to provide for the remuneration of such officers and servants as may be required, and for the reasonable travelling and other expenses of the Board.

The said Resolution, being read a second time, was agreed to.

Ordered, That Mr. Rogers have leave to bring in a Bill to incorporate the National Gallery of Canada.

He accordingly presented the said Bill to the House, and the same was received and read the first time; and ordered to be read a second time at the next sitting of the House.

And then The House, having continued to sit till five minutes after Eleven of the Clock, P.M., adjourned till Monday next.
