PRAYERS.

Mr. Pepin, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid upon the Table,— Copy of Protocol extending for a period of three years, with the exception of Article IX, the Trade Agreement between Canada and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics of 1956. Done at Ottawa, March 1, 1970. (English and French). Sessional Paper No. 6/150.

The Order being read for the second reading and reference to the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development of Bill C-187, An Act respecting inland water resources in the Yukon Territory and Northwest Territories;

Mr. Chrétien, seconded by Mr. Drury, moved,—That the said bill be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Indian Affairs and Northern Development.
