## Letters threatening to murder.

15. Whosoever maliciously sends, delivers, or utters, or directly or Sending letindirectly causes to be received, knowing the contents thereof, any ters threaten-letter or writing threatening to kill or murder any person, is guilty of 15 felony, and shall be liable to be imprisoned in the Penitentiary for any

term not exceeding ten years and not less than two years, or to be imprisoned in any other gaol or place of confinement for any term less than two years, with or without hard labour, and with or without solitary confinement, and, if a male under the age of sixteen years, with 20 or without whipping.

## Acts causing or tending to cause danger to life or bodily harm.

16. Whosoever unlawfully and maliciously prevents or impedes any Impeding a person, being on board of or having quitted any ship or vessel in dis- person en-tress, or wrocked stranded or cast on shore in his or downame to geavoring to tress, or wrecked, stranded, or cast on shore, in his endeavour to save save himself his life, or unlawfully and maliciously prevents or impedes any person from ship-

Whosoever unlawfully and maliciously, by any means whatso-Shooting or ever, wounds or causes any grievous bodily harm to any person, or attempting to shoots at any person, or, by drawing a trigger or in any other manner, wounding attempts to discharge any kind of loaded arms at any person, with intent with intent to 35 in any of the cases aforesaid to maim, disfigure or disable any person, do grievous or to do some other grievous bodily harm to any person, or with the bodily harm.
