## REPEAL

Repeal. 1960-61, c. 4. (1) The National Productivity Council Act is repealed.

> (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), any act or thing required to be done by the National Productivity Council for the purpose of enabling the said Council to give effect to subsection (3) may be done in all respects as though the National Productivity Council Act had continued in force.

(3) Forthwith after the coming into force of this Act, any amount standing to the credit of the National Productivity Council after the payment by it of any debts 10 or other obligations thereof shall be paid by the said Council to the Receiver General of Canada to be held and applied towards the payment of the expenses referred to in section 19 as though that amount had been appropriated by Parliament for such purpose.
