

To these Bills the Royal Assent was pronounced by the Clerk of the Senate in the following words:—

“In Her Majesyt’s name, the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Administrator doth assent to these Bills”.

The Commons withdrew.

After which the Honourable the Deputy of His Excellency the Administrator was pleased to retire.

The Senate resumed.

With leave of the Senate, and—

On motion of the Honourable Senator Macdonald, P.C., it was—

Ordered, That when the Senate adjourns to-day, it do stand adjourned until to-morrow at eight o’clock in the evening.

The Senate adjourned.
