Spirits or Strong Waters not being sweetened or mixed with any article, so that the degree of strength thereof cannot be as- certained by Sykes' Hydrome- ter, for every gallon of the strength of proof by such hy- drometer, and so in proportion for any greater or less strength than the strength of proof, and for any greater or less quantity than a gallon, viz. :—

Wines of all kinds, except Spark- ling Wines, containing not over 26 degrees of proof spirits by Sykes' Hydrometer, in wood...	" 0 10	20 per cent.
