1. Operators or Station Masters employed on Hours of attendthe Telegraph are expected to be at their ance. offices daily, ready for business, from 8 A.M., until dismissed for the night by the Superintendent in charge of their division.

Telegraphing Standard Time.

- 2. At five minutes before nine a.m. daily, Attendance dureach Operator must be at his instrument, and of time.

 REMAIN WITH KEY CLOSED and spring WELL ADJUSTED to receive the standard time of the road.
- 3. At three minutes before nine o'clock Receiving of precisely, the Operator at the Head Office, will time. commence beating time with his key, and will continue this until NINE o'clock PRECISELY when he will say "i. i." for one minute, and sign.
- 4. The clocks at each station must, during Regulating the this time, be carefully and EXACTLY set by the
