Head Master of a Normal or Model-School in which there may be more than one Teacher; and for all the purposes of this Act, Incorporated Villages shall be implied in the terms "Township, Town and City," and the word "School," shall likewise mean Schools and shall apply to Schools for females as well as males, and such Villages shall be entitled to all the privileges, and be under all the obligations belonging to Townships, Towns and Cities, by virtue of and under the authority of this Act.

I.XXXI. And be it enacted, That upon, from and Repeal of former Acts and after the first day of January of the year one thousand commenceeight hundred and fifty, all Laws and Statutes hereto- Ment of this Act. fore or now in force for the establishment and maintenance of Common Schools in Upper-Canada, or for the amendment of any such Laws or Statutes, shall be repealed; and that this Act shall have force and effect, upon, from and after the said day, and not before; Excepting always, that it may and shall provise as to be lawful for the Governor, immediately after the measures. passing of this Act, to issue any Commission, or make any appointments, or for the Governor in Council to adopt such preparatory measures for the carrying out the provisions of this Act as he may deem expedient; such Commission, appointments and measures to come into force upon, from and after the said first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and not before.
