Three months since, Mr. Keith, a mining engineer, was commissioned to undertake a careful investigation of the geological conditions existing thereabouts, and his investigations seemingly establish the fact that the rocks of Haliburton are impregnated with gold. Some contact veins have been found and from one of these in the Township of Harburn a quantity of ore was taken for analysis, and pronounced to be sufficiently. The Independent, were sent to J. F.
