At a meeting of the Parry Island Band Council held on March 4, the following resolution was passed.

Moved by Stanley Manitowaba, Seconded by Peter Judge, that Elijah Tabobandung be granted a permit to cut 500 logs which he proposes to exchange for building material, it being his intention to build a house. I believe that 300 logs would be sufficient for this purpose and recommend that a permit be granted for that amount, to be free of dues if used as indicated. In the event that any of the logs should be sold, dues and stumpage would be payable at the rate of \$10.50 per thousand feet for pine logs and \$5.00 for hemlock.
